

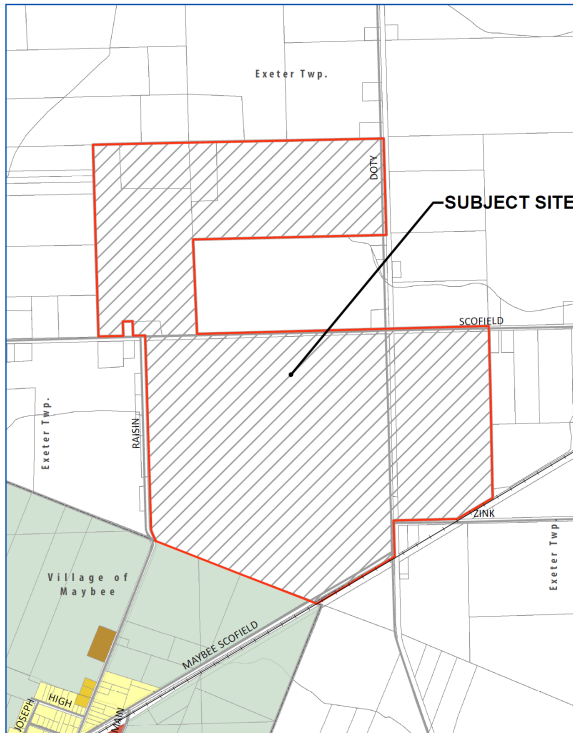
VILLAGE OF MAYBEE

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Village of Maybee Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, January 8, 2014, beginning at 7:00 p.m., at the Village Hall located at 9051 Raisin Street, Maybee, Michigan.

The hearing will be to hear public comment on two proposed amendments to the Village of Maybee Zoning Ordinance.

The first amendment is a map amendment to classify the recently annexed Stoneco property as "Agricultural." This amendment affects the following parcels:

The second amendment is a text amendment to two subsections of Section 19(H) of the Ordinance addressing special land use specific design standards for extractive uses. The amendment to subsection (2) would allow flexibility in addressing setbacks as special use conditions; the amendment to subsection (5) would permit flexibility while keeping necessary options for review by the Village as circumstances may warrant.
