Carried.

<u>Correspondence:</u> A letter was received from Monroe Publishing Co. regarding a 90 minute seminar on Open Meetings Act and FOIA.

<u>Ordinance Officer Report:</u> The issues that were brought to Council were grass cutting along Bluebush Rd. opposite Independent Dairy, streetlights out on Baldwin Rd. as well as a water leak on High St. near the Church.

Old Business

Report on Maybee Park & Baseball Diamonds: Bob VanAuker has been working at the park on the baseball diamonds spreading screening several times. Stone Co. has donated stone for the fields.

<u>Property on 7525 Bluebush Road:</u> This issue is still in the process of being handeled by our village attorneys.

Repaving of Maybee Scofield Road: Council members were informed that this issue is still in the process of the road being surveyed due to the fact that their was a shortage of surveyors and more are being brought in to complete the survey of the road.

New Business

Report on Open Meetings Act Seminar: President Gaylor attended this seminar and reported several laws associated with the Open Meetings Act that their lead attorney spoke about.

Report on F.O.I.A. Rules Seminar: Council members were given packets regarding all the F.O.I.A. Procedures & Guidelines for The Village of Maybee. Each topic was discussed individually and after all discussion, a motion was made for these requirements to be adopted. **Motion: Archer 2nd Gross** to have all the F.O.I.A. Procedures & Guidelines looked at by our

village attorney so everything is legal and for the O.K. To be put on our website and become Adopted. Carried. A Roll Call was then taken for this issue.
