License: Mr. Gavor and his lawyer, Mr. Canzano, approached the Council to ask for approval to obtain a liquor license and sell liquor in the gas station located at 7595 Blue Bush Rd.

The Council requests that Mr. Gavor reimburse the Village for attorney fees due to the license.

Mr. Gavor agreed to cover the attorney fees as well as any additional expenses the Village may encounter relating to the liquor license.

Mr. Borbely will be fundraising and accepting donations for this project to raise an estimated total of \$2,000-\$2,500.

L.M.R 2022 Fire Budget

The 2022 budget has increased to \$3,173.30 a month from the 2021 budget of \$2,838.14 a month.

Monroe County Sheriff Troy Goodnough Sheriff Goodnough came to report on 2021 in the Village. He mentions that the Village had 34 calls in 2021, which is up by 9 compared to 25 calls in 2020. Sheriff Goodnough feels that response time to calls in the Village and Exeter township have improved from having the substation in the Village. The non-emergency line to the Sheriff's department is (734) 243-7070.

Empty Seats on Zoning Board of Appeal and Planning Commission The empty seat on the Zoning Board of Appeal was filled by Tonia Satkowska and the empty seat on the Planning Commission was filled by Brad Rogers.

Motion to Add Tonia Satkowska to Zoning Board and Brad Rogers to Planning Commission: Archer, 2nd Venman Carried.

A resident brought up a concern regarding signage on Raisin St. and whether a specific stretch of Raisin St. was the Village or Monroe County. The Village said we will look into the concern regarding the signs.
