The village council approved the purchase of new equipment for maintaining the sewer system in the village at the last council meeting. This will make it easier to locate a problem and make the repair in a faster and more cost efficient manner. It was also learned that the bid for the downtown streetscape was accepted by the State and it was \$2,000 under the estimate. The work on repaying the downtown roads will start next week with the streetscape portion starting in August. The work that has been going on for the past ten days has been the City of Monroe repairing potential future problems before the new roads were put in. The tar filling of the cracks in the road is almost complete and this should allow the roads to hold up a little better during the Winter freeze.
