Approval of Agenda: After Council reviewed tonight's agenda a motion was made for approval

Motion: Gramlich 2nd Gross to approve the agenda for tonight's meeting. Carried.

Reading of Minutes: Upon completion of reading the minutes a motion was made for approval. **Motion: Archer 2**nd **Rogers** to approve the reading of the March 9, 2016 minutes with corrections. Carried.

Upon completion of this resolution being read a motion was introduced by Councilman Archer.

<u>Motion: Archer 2nd Gramlich</u> to adopt this new Resolution on Ballfield as read by President Gaylor. A roll call was then taken by Clerk Gross and afterwards there were 5 ya's & 0 nays. The Resolution was then declared passed.

<u>Sewer Cleaning on Raisin St.</u> Council members were made aware that there is an issue with a sewer near a residents home. Surveyors have been out to assess the problem and the Monroe Co. Drain Commission will be handling this project with their equipment.
