At the February council meeting the budget for the LMR Fire Department was approved. This year 18% of the budget will be the responsibility of the village. Also discussed was the need for a back-up generator for the pumping station of the sanitary sewer system. In the past the Monroe County Drain Commission would have to bring in a portable unit due to power outages. This has become to costly to continue.

Another item approved was the extension of the sanitary and storm sewer lines at the North end of Raisin Street. This will accommodate any new construction that will be taking place.

The council also passed a resolution to commit a portion of the general fund account for the updating and maintaining of the villages infrastructure.
