Village of Maybee Board Meeting 12/09/2020

President Gaylor opened the meeting at 7:15 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance following the yearly budget meeting.

<u>Reading of the Minutes:</u> The minutes were read by Clerk Hartford. <u>Motion: Archer, 2nd Venman:</u> to approve the minutes of the November 11, 2020 meeting. Carried.

Budget Amendments: There are four amendments needed in the General Fund. The Clerk Salary account needs to be increased by \$2,000 for a new budget amount of \$18,000. Under Village Hall and Grounds, the Landscape Maintenance needs to be increased by \$200 for a new budget of \$2,200. The Building Inspector account needs to be increased by \$500 for a new budget amount of \$7,500. Under Public Works the Street Lighting needs to be increased by \$2,000 for a budget total of \$28,000. **Motion: Archer, 2nd Shaw:** to approve the budget amendments listed above. Carried.

<u>Reading of the Bills:</u> The bills were reviewed and a motion was made. **Motion: L. Gramlich, 2nd Venman:** to pay the bills as presented. Carried.

Treasurer's Report: Accepted as printed.

OLD BUSINESS

<u>Street Administrator Report</u> Nothing new to report. Mark said some of the drains were plugged by leaves at the end of November. The street light at Bluebush and Baldwin was finally repaired this past Monday as reported by Clerk Hartford.

<u>Christmas With Santa</u> Everything went very well with Santa greeting children in the drive thru at the Credit Union. We had an excellent turn out for the event. Treat bags for the children were donated by the Credit Union. We handed out about 95 bags. Special thanks to Sam's Pizzeria for the donation of pizza's for all of the volunteers. Thank you to Larry and Mike Gramlich for helping with the parking. Thank you also to Nick Archer for the donation of hand and toe warmers for the volunteers.

<u>Update on Sidewalk Ordinance</u> Len has found that all we have on file is a Special Assessment for sidewalks. This would mean a special hearing would need to be held each time a sidewalk needs replacing. Plans are to have a legal ordinance as well as a billing schedule in place early next year.

<u>Marijuana Ordinance</u> In keeping within the guidelines provided by Michigan Municipal League we found that the ordinances need to be published in the newspaper. In the past, we published them on our website. Therefore, we are re-issuing this ordinance so that it's current and it will be published in The Monroe News.

<u>Village Sub-Station</u> The Monroe County Sheriff's office is interested in putting a sub-station here in Maybee. They have talked with Len and plans are for them to use the old building so they can park a vehicle inside and also have space for an office.

<u>Village Budget</u> The yearly Budget meeting was held at 7:00 pm tonight to review the budgets set for all the funds of the Village of Maybee for the year 2021. The Parks and Recreation Budget will be set at a later date.
