

VILLAGE OF MAYBEE
RESOLUTION ALLOWING OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS
ON CERTAIN VILLAGE STREETS
Adopted June 10th, 2026

WHEREAS, Public Act 491 of 2014, MCL 257.657a of the Michigan Vehicle Code authorizes a village with a population of fewer than 30,000 individuals based upon the 2010 census to permit, by resolution, the operation of golf carts on the streets of that village; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Maybee had a population of less than 30,000 based on the 2010 decennial census and does currently as well; and

WHEREAS, golf cart means a vehicle designed for transportation while playing the game of golf and which would be exempt from the requirements of the Insurance Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Maybee desires to permit the operation of golf carts on its streets in accordance with the provisions of MCL 257.657a and the terms of this Resolution for any year during which this Resolution shall remain in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. Pursuant to MCL 257.657a, effective June 10th, 2026, the Village of Maybee hereby allows the operation of golf carts on local Village streets in accordance with the provisions of MCL 257.657a.
2. The use of any golf cart on local streets in the Village of Maybee shall comply with all of the following:
 - A. A person shall be at least 16 years old and licensed to operate a motor vehicle in order to operate a golf cart on any street.
 - B. A person operating a golf cart upon a street shall ride as near to the right side of the street as practicable and shall exercise due care when passing a standing vehicle or a vehicle proceeding in the same direction.
 - C. A person operating a golf cart shall not pass between lanes of traffic, but may pass on the left of traffic moving in his or her direction in the case of a two-way street or on the left or right of traffic in the case of a one-way street, in an unoccupied lane.
 - D. A golf cart shall not be operated on a sidewalk constructed for use by pedestrians.
 - E. The roads designated for use by golf carts within the limits of the Village of Maybee are as follows: All Local Roads.

F. A golf cart shall not be operated on streets during the time period from a half hour before sunset to a half hour after sunrise.

G. A golf cart shall not be operated at a speed of in excess of 15 miles per hour.

H. A golf cart shall not be operated on a highway or street with a speed limit of more than 30 miles per hour, except to cross that highway or street.

I. The operator of a golf cart shall comply with the signal requirements of Motor Vehicle Code Section 648 that apply to the operation of a vehicle.

J. A golf cart operated on a Village of Maybee street is not required to be registered under the Michigan Vehicle Code for purposes of Section 3101 of the Insurance Code. Section 3101 of the Insurance Code establishes a requirement that the owner or registrant of a motor vehicle required to be registered maintain automobile insurance coverage.

3. The Village Clerk is directed to provide a final copy of this Resolution to the applicable enforcement agencies for their information forthwith.

4. This Resolution may be amended, extended or terminated by resolution of the Village Council should the Council deem it prudent or necessary to do so.

5. All resolutions and parts of resolutions are to the extent of any conflict with this resolution rescinded.
