Blue Bush Rd. Repave and Sidewalk Work Updates - President Joel Grubb spoke about the completion of Blue Bush Rd.

President Joel Grubb had a discussion with Council Members regarding the lines that were put on Blue Bush Rd. after the repave.

Sheriff Goodnough Annual Report – Sheriff Troy Goodnough was present and spoke about the statistical data from the past 4 years.

Sheriff Troy Goodnough suggested speaking with surrounding Townships to pool funds to purchase a portable speed limit sign to capture data to assist with what portions of the roads need to be patrolled.

Sheriff Troy Goodnough spoke about assigning 4 deputies to the Village of Maybee's substation.

Sheriff Troy Goodnough spoke about hiring an officer to patrol the truck route roads 42 hours a week to stop large, overloaded trucks from traveling down roadways that are not permitted for heavy haulers.

Sheriff Troy Goodnough will be increasing to 115 law enforcement officers in Monroe County, MI.

Beautification Committee Report – Council member and beautification member, L. Orrison spoke about beautification committee member S. Lentner's request to place more plants at the corner gas station. L. Orrison spoke about purchasing 5 mums for the gas station.

Snow Removal Discussion – President Joel Grubb spoke about reaching out to 4 snow removal companies to receive quotes. President Joel Grubb informed council members and present Village residents that the companies were not interested in providing a quote.
